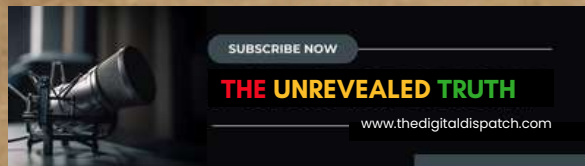

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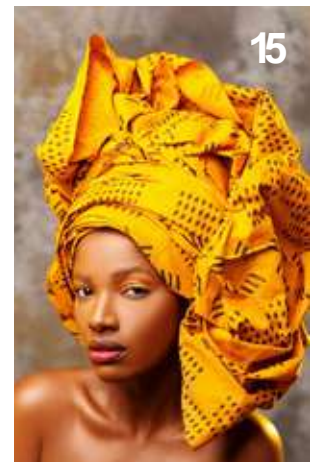

The Spiritual Sound of Zimbabwe

Driving in the streets of Edmonton, with snow on either side of the roads and slippery every time the brakes are applied, one would never dream of hearing Zimbabwe's traditional Mbira music playing loudly from a parked car with windows and doors wide open.

I swiftly made a perfect U-turn to talk to the men who are all in their late 40s.

Hey guys, what's up? You seem to be enjoying your music, but wait can't you feel the cold and the temperature is -18 degrees Celsius.

"Sup buddy, wanna join? We're Canadians bro, forget about the weather can't you hear some good music from Africa," replied one the guys.

"Well, it's music from Zimbabwe, let me check online to see the name of the artist. Here is it, Ronald Nyandoro," added one of them.

We talked for a couple of minutes and thanked them for their kind reception.



That night I went home and browsed through the internet to look for more information about this artist, Ronald Nyandoro. It turned out he is based in Canada and through various efforts I managed to get his contacts and booked an appointment to meet him in person.

I went prepared, not to waste any opportunity given and within minutes of introducing myself I set up my equipment and was ready for the interview. (Interview available on our YouTube Channel).

ON MBIRA music:

Nyandoro took me through his musical journey.

"My musical journey is rooted in Mhondoro, Zimbabwe, where my earliest connection to the mbira was forged by listening to community elders. Entirely self-taught, this passion followed me to Canada, where I relocated for academic and professional pursuits. Over years of dedicated practice, my skills matured, culminating in a pivotal realization in 2014: my profound connection to the mbira demanded not just private practice but a formal, recorded expression to honor its legacy and share its voice."



Nyandoro boasts of two albums which have done well considering he is not doing music as a full-time job. He has been producing and recording his music through renowned music producer, Munya Vialy (also based in Canada).

About Mbira Music & the Instrument

Today, Mbira stands as a powerful symbol of resilience and identity. Its captivating sound continues to inspire musicians worldwide, serving as a timeless reminder of music's power to connect the past with the present, and the earthly with the divine.

The mbira, often called a "thumb piano" in the West, is far more than a simple melodic instrument. For centuries, it has been the spiritual and cultural heartbeat of the Shona people of Zimbabwe, a resonant bridge between the living and the ancestral world.

Crafted from a wooden soundboard, a series of carefully tuned metal or bamboo tines (keys) are attached, which are plucked by the player's thumbs and right forefinger. This creates a mesmerizing, polyphonic, and polyrhythmic sound, a cascade of interlocking patterns that is both hypnotically complex and deeply soothing. The instrument is often placed inside a large calabash resonator (deze) to amplify its ethereal, bell-like tones, which many describe as sounding like "falling water."

In traditional Shona culture, mbira is not merely for entertainment. It is sacred, used primarily in all-night ceremonies known as bira. During these gatherings, the repetitive, cyclical music of the mbira is believed to attract ancestral spirits (vadzimu), inviting them to join the community, offer guidance, and help resolve problems. The music, therefore, is a form of prayer and a direct line to the spiritual realm.

The mbira's repertoire consists of hundreds of ancient pieces, each with its own spiritual and social purpose. In the 20th and 21st centuries, artists like Thomas Mapfumo revolutionized African music by electrifying the mbira and blending its ancient patterns with modern guitar and drums, creating the popular genre known as Chimurenga music. This brought the mbira's profound sound to a global audience.

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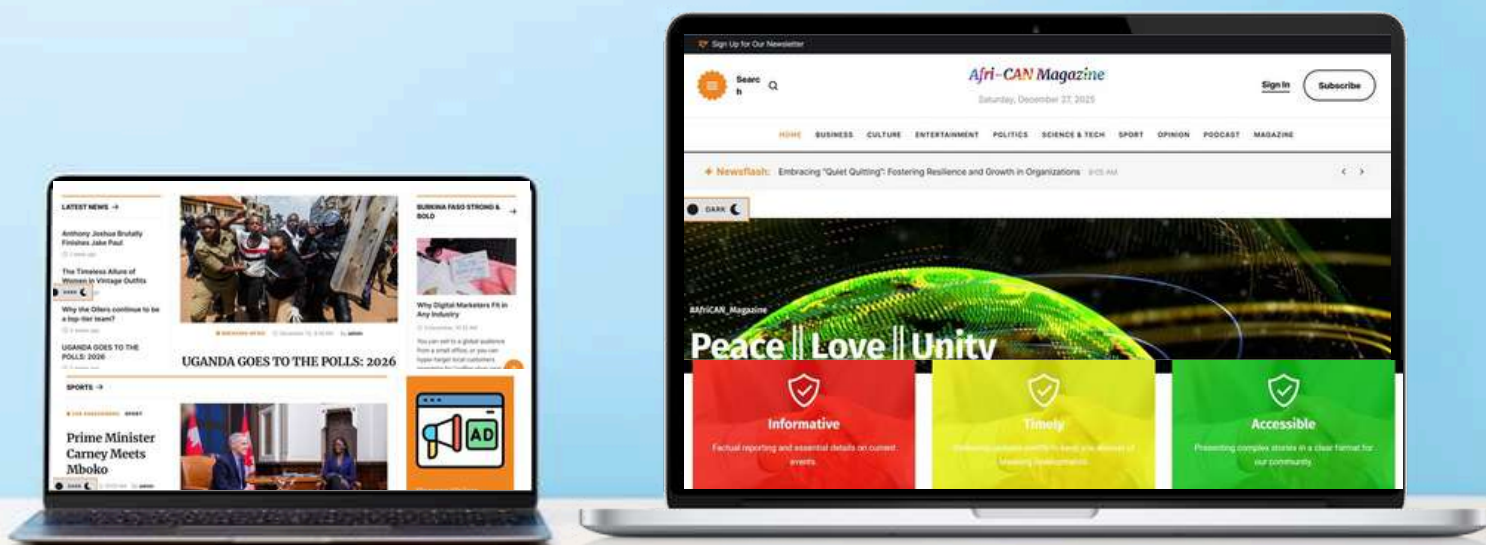

Elections in Uganda

As Uganda enters the long shadow of its 2026 general election, the political landscape is not simply preparing for another contest; it is a pressure cooker testing the very foundations of a system that has held power for nearly four decades.



President Yoweri Museveni, in power since 1986 and freshly confirmed as the National Resistance Movement (NRM) flag-bearer, seeks a seventh term that would extend his rule past the 45-year mark.



The present situation is defined not by new candidates, but by a hardening of long-standing political realities and the simmering tensions they produce.

The most prominent development is the apparent consolidation of the status quo. The ruling NRM machinery, a vast network of patronage and state resources, is already in motion.

Bobi Wine once said;

"It's not a contest between those who support NRM versus those who support the 'Opposition'. That false narrative is driven by the Museveni system. NO. It is the majority of Ugandans versus a small clique of armed people who believe that the country belongs to them as of right."

"It is a contest between those who believe in democracy and those who believe in 'divine right'. Those who believe in the rule of law versus those who believe in the rule of the gun. Those who believe in human dignity versus those who believe in abductions, torture, and murder."

"It is a contest between the oppressed and their oppressors. In short, it is a contest between what is right, fair and just on one hand, and what is evil and immoral on the other hand."

The recent passage of contentious legislation, including the Computer Misuse (Amendment) Act, 2022, which critics label a tool to stifle online dissent, signals a pre-electoral environment where digital spaces, crucial for opposition organizing, are under increased scrutiny.

Uganda grapples with high youth unemployment, rising inflation, and the burdens of public debt. These pressures are acutely felt by the nation's overwhelmingly young population, a demographic that overwhelmingly backed the opposition in 2021. This creates a potent paradox: a government seeking renewal from a generation increasingly impatient for change it has yet to materially deliver. The government points to major infrastructure projects like oil pipelines and roads as proof of development, but the tangible benefits for ordinary citizens remain a central point of political debate.

However, the most profound "development" may be a growing sense of political fatigue and strategic recalibration. The violent, chaotic scenes that marred the 2021 election, including widespread internet shutdowns and military deployment, remain fresh in public memory. This has led to questions about the opposition's next move. Is the path one of continued, risky mass mobilization, or a slower, more subterranean build-up of grassroots structures? The space for traditional campaigning remains severely constricted, pushing political discourse into fragmented community meetings and onto heavily monitored social media platforms.

Internationally, the lens is also shifting. While Western donors often issue muted statements on governance, regional partners and new international actors, particularly China, maintain a firm policy of non-interference, insulating the regime from certain diplomatic pressures. This allows the government to frame the election as a purely sovereign affair.



As the drumbeat towards the election grows louder, the fundamental question is not merely "Who will win?", the incumbent holds every institutional advantage. The more thought-provoking dilemma is: What form will political expression take in a system designed to limit it? The gathering storm may not bring immediate change, but the atmospheric pressure it creates will define the nation's trajectory for a generation.

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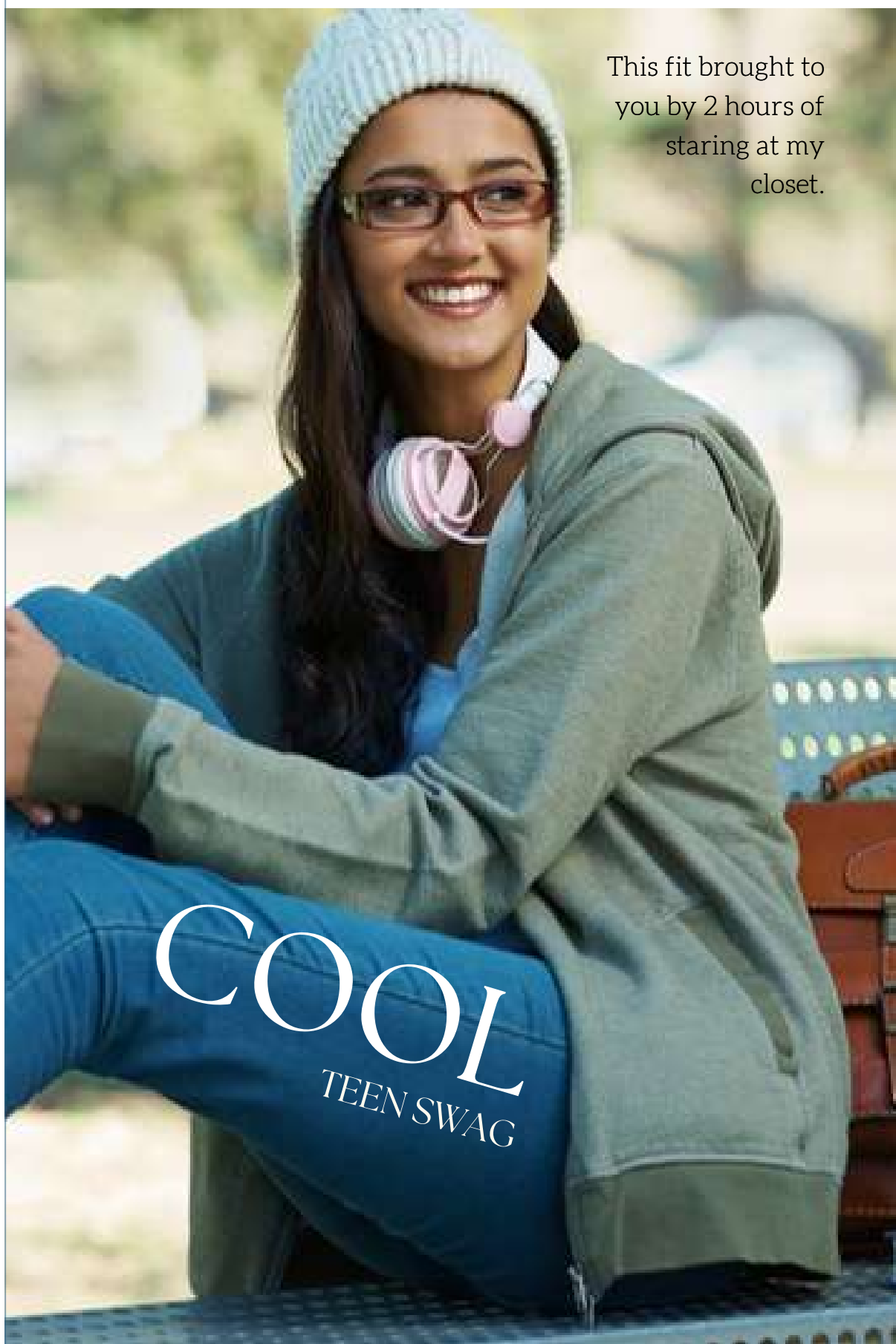

As of April 1, 2025, one must obtain a Special Flight Operations Certificate (SFOC-RPAS) to operate a microdrone at an advertised event, such as a concert, festival or sporting event.

IMPORTANT: US VISA UPDATES



Effective January 1, 2026

In line with Presidential Proclamation 10998 on "Restricting and Limiting the Entry of Foreign Nationals to Protect the Security of the United States," which takes effect on January 1, 2026, at 12:01 a.m. Eastern Standard Time (EST), the United States is fully or partially suspending entry for and visa issuance to nationals of 39 countries

Suspension of Visa Issuance to Foreign Nationals

Also effective January 1, 2026, at 12:01 a.m. EST, in line with Presidential Proclamation 10998 on "Restricting and Limiting the Entry of Foreign Nationals to Protect the Security of the United States," the Department of State is partially suspending visa issuance to nationals of 19 countries – Angola, Antigua and Barbuda, Benin, Burundi, Cote D'Ivoire, Cuba, Dominica, Gabon, The Gambia, Malawi, Mauritania, Nigeria, Senegal, Tanzania, Togo, Tonga, Venezuela, Zambia, and Zimbabwe – for nonimmigrant B-1/B-2 visitor visas and F, M, J student and exchange visitor visas, and all immigrant visas with limited exceptions for:

- Immigrant visas for ethnic and religious minorities facing persecution in Iran
- Dual nationals applying with a passport nationality not subject to a suspension
- Special Immigrant Visas (SIVs) for U.S. government employees under 8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(27)(D)
- Participants in certain major sporting events
- Lawful Permanent Residents (LPRs)

SWEET & FUN COUPLES HOME WORKOUT

NO EQUIPMENT NEEDED. 20-25 MINUTES. FOCUS ON TEAMWORK AND MOTIVATION!

Warm-Up (3-5 mins)

Do each for 60 seconds.

- **High-Five Jumping Jacks:** Face each other, do jumping jacks and high-five on each clap overhead.
- **Squat & Reach:** Hold hands, squat together, then rise and reach arms overhead.
- **Torso Twists:** Stand back-to-back, gently twist to tap each other's hands on each side.

The Partner Circuit (3 rounds, 60 sec work)

- **Partner Squats (Facing Each Other):** Hold each other's forearms for balance.
- Lower into a squat in sync, keeping your chests up. Press up together.

Push-Up High-Fives

- Get into a push-up position facing each other, hands shoulder-width apart.
- Lower into a push-up. As you push up, lift your right hand to high-five your partner's right hand. Alternate sides.

Sit-Up Pass

- Sit facing each other, knees bent, feet touching.
- Hold a pillow, water bottle, or small object.
- As you both lower back, pass the object behind you. As you sit up, pass it back overhead. Keep the core tight!

Assisted Lunges

- Partner A stands tall. Partner B places their hands on Partner A's shoulders.
- Partner B steps back into a reverse lunge while Partner A provides light support for balance. Do all reps on one side before switching.

Plank Tap Challenge

- Both get into a high plank facing each other, about arm's length apart.
- Take turns lifting one hand to quickly tap your partner's shoulder. Keep those hips steady!

Cooldown & Stretch (3-5 mins)

- **Seated Forward Fold (Back-to-Back):** Sit back-to-back with legs straight. Gently take turns leaning forward to stretch the other person's back and hamstrings.
- **Partner Chest Opener:** Sit facing each other, cross-legged. Hold each other's forearms and gently lean back to open up the chest and shoulders.
- **Figure-Four Stretch:** Sit facing each other and help each other into a gentle figure-four glute stretch.

Let's take this...BUT HERE IS A TIP

Make it fun! Play your favorite upbeat playlist, keep each other accountable on form, and celebrate with a high-five or fun dance move after each round.





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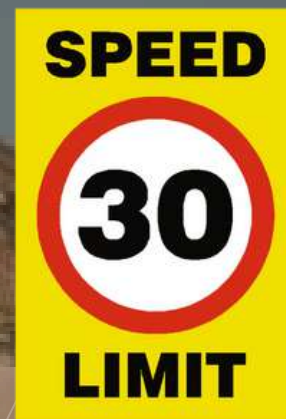
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EDUCATIONAL GOALS 2026

**CELEBRATING
RHUMBA MUSIC**

KOFI OLOMIDE BORN ANTOINE CHRISTOPHE AGBEPAMUMBA

Koffi Olomide is Congolese rumba artist whose name is synonymous with a distinct, transformative excellence that reshaped the genre for a global era. His genius lies not merely in performance but in total artistic authorship; he is the prolific composer, visionary arranger, charismatic bandleader, and magnetic showman all in one.

While deeply rooted in the classic sebene guitar traditions of Kinshasa, Koffi pioneered the smoother, slower, and more melodic style known as "Tcha Tcho" in the 1990s, a sophisticated and romantic sound that captivated audien-

-ces across Africa and beyond with its polished elegance and emotional depth.

Beyond the music, he crafted an unparalleled spectacle, elevating the concert experience into a grand theatrical production of synchronized choreography, lavish costumes, and an almost orchestral command of his ensembles. Anthems like "Droit de Veto," "Loi," and "Effrakata" are cultural landmarks, cementing his status as a maestro whose controversial persona is inextricable from his undeniable, generation-defining impact as a musical innovator and an icon of extravagant, enduring artistry.

Fally Ipupa

Fally Ipupa N'simba, born in 1977 in Kinshasa, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), is the artist who masterfully bridged the golden age of Congolese rumba with the sounds of the 21st century, earning his title as a modern "Rhumba King."

Growing up in the shadow of the legendary Quartier Latin orchestra, led by the iconic Papa Wemba, Fally was not just a fan but a devoted disciple. In 1999, his raw talent and dedication was recognized, and he was invited to join the very group he idolized. As a guitarist, composer, and vocalist for Quartier Latin, he spent nearly a decade honing his craft, absorbing the complex sebene guitar work and sophisticated harmonies that define Congolese rumba.

His solo debut in 2006, "Droit Chemin," was a monumental success. The album was a declaration of a new sonic vision: it preserved the soulful, danceable essence of classic rumba (ndombolo) but infused it with sleek, contemporary R&B, hip-hop, and pop influences. His live performances became the stuff of legend. With impeccable style, intricate choreography, and a magnetic stage presence, his concerts are immersive experiences that affirm his royal status. He is not just a singer; he is a complete entertainer in the grand tradition of Congolese music.

Today, Fally stands as a colossal figure. He is the "Rhumba King" because he inherited a priceless throne, modernized its palace with global sounds, and continues to rule with a commitment to musical excellence, ensuring that Congolese rumba remains both timeless and utterly contemporary.



Roga Roga

ROGA ROGA, which translates from Lingala as "squabble" or "chaos," is far more than just a provocative name, it is the moniker of one of the most resilient, influential, and sonically robust ensembles in the history of modern Congolese rumba, a group whose very existence is a testament to the genre's enduring power and its capacity for reinvention amidst the literal and metaphorical turbulence of its homeland. Emerging from the fertile musical landscape of Kinshasa in the 1980s, Roga Roga was founded by the late visionary composer, guitarist, and singer Bimi Ombale, who sought to create a unit that prioritized raw rhythmic drive, intricate guitar work, and socially conscious lyrics.



Extra Musica

Emerging as a titan in the golden era of modern Congolese rumba, Extra Musica distinguished itself through an uncompromising commitment to musical sophistication and powerful, harmonious vocals. Founded in the 1990s by the masterful guitarist and songwriter Bopol Mansiamina, alongside the exceptional vocal prowess of Werre Werre and Ferre Gola, the ensemble quickly became synonymous with excellence, crafting a sound that was both elegantly refined and intensely emotional. For a definitive period, Extra Musica set the standard for artistic integrity and sonic perfection in Kinshasa's competitive music scene, leaving a legacy that continues to inspire awe for its technical mastery and profound emotional delivery.

Kanda Bongo Man

Kanda Bongo Man stands as a pioneering architect who fundamentally transformed and globalized Congolese rumba for the 1980s and beyond, masterfully streamlining the genre's complex, guitar-driven orchestration into an irresistibly fast, compact, and internationally accessible dance phenomenon known as "Kwassa Kwassa."



RHUMBA Excellence & History

Congolese rumba stands as one of the 20th century's most influential and enduring musical movements, a genre born from the profound fusion of African rhythmic tradition and Afro-Cuban son that returned to the continent via records in the late 1930s and 1940s, where it was joyfully reclaimed and reinvented by pioneering artists in the burgeoning urban centers of Kinshasa and Brazzaville.

Orchestras like African Jazz and OK Jazz, led respectively by the visionary Grand Kalle and the legendary Franco (Luambo Makiadi), crafted the foundational sound, characterized by intertwining guitar melodies (mi-solo and sebene), poetic Lingala lyrics, and rhythms that moved the soul and the body.

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Over decades, rumba evolved through distinct phases: from the elegant, big-band era of the 1950s and '60s, through the kinetic, dance-driven soukous and ndombolo explosions of the 1970s and '80s, to its modern, globally-infused iterations carried by icons like Koffi Olomide and Fally Ipupa.

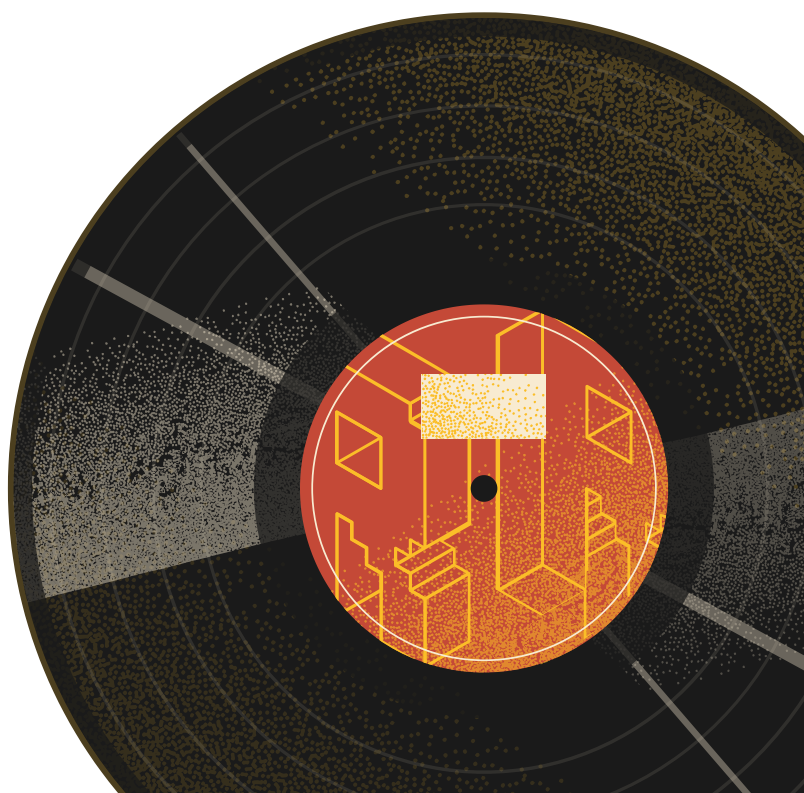
More than just music, Congolese rumba became a vital cultural force, a soundtrack for independence, a voice of social commentary, a language of romance, and an irresistible call to dance that has transcended borders, resonating across Africa and the world.

His genius lay in a brilliant simplification: by foregrounding the melodic lead guitar and pairing it with insistent, bouncing basslines, he distilled the essence of the Congolese sebene into a hypnotic, circular groove that was both immediately catchy and endlessly danceable.

Songs like "Sai" and "Lela Lela" became global anthems, introducing the vibrant sounds of soukous to European and world music charts through his dynamic live performances and crisp studio productions. While operating far from Kinshasa, his work did not abandon tradition but rather re-engineered it for a new context, becoming a crucial bridge that carried the joyous, rhythmic heart of Congolese music across continents and solidifying his legacy as an ambassador of pure, unadulterated dance-floor euphoria.



Its excellence lies in this unparalleled adaptability and emotional depth, a continuous thread of melodic sophistication, rhythmic innovation, and communal joy that has sustained its relevance for nearly a century, proving it to be not merely a genre, but a living, breathing legacy of artistic resilience and unity.



Lifestyle, *Fashion* *Music*, & Culture

The Soundtrack of Belonging

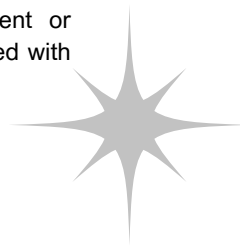

Culture also operates on a macro scale, responding to and influencing societal shifts. The rise of minimalist lifestyles and fashion, for instance, intertwines with growing environmental consciousness (culture) and is often paired with ambient or simplistic musical aesthetics. Here, identity becomes aligned with a broader ethical and philosophical stance.



The Digital Catalyst

The digital realm has accelerated this fusion to light speed. Platforms like TikTok, Instagram, Roblox, and Spotify are modern-day cultural cauldrons. A dance trend originating in Nigeria can inspire fashion choices in Brazil, influence the sound of a pop song produced in Sweden, and become part of a teenager's lifestyle in Japan, all within a week. The internet has democratized access, allowing individuals to curate their identity from a global palette, creating hyper-personalized mosaics of influence.

This intertwining is not a new phenomenon. The flappers of the 1920s fused jazz music (a cultural product of the African American experience), shorter dresses (a fashion rebellion), and a lifestyle of increased female autonomy to create an iconic identity of liberation. The punk movement of the 1970s was a furious fusion of abrasive music, DIY fashion (safety pins, torn clothing), and a lifestyle staunchly opposed to mainstream consumer culture.

What has changed is the pace, scale, and self-awareness of the curation. We are now active architects of our identity, consciously selecting from an endless array of influences. The fusion of lifestyle, fashion, music, and culture is how we answer the fundamental questions: "Who am I?" and "Where do I belong?"

In the end, our identity is this very fusion, a living, breathing collage. It is in the choice to pair a grandfather's watch with a tech-driven lifestyle, to listen to both classical symphonies and electronic dance music, to honor cultural traditions while embracing global citizenship. This interplay is not chaotic but creative. It is the human process of making meaning, finding community, and ultimately, composing the unique and ever-changing song of the self.
